

## I. NOTICE

The Helena Lewin Chair in Latin American Studies at the University of Haifa will publish its second edition of Latinam-Zine, which focuses on ethnohistorical, anthropological, environmental and ecological issues, related to the indigenous populations, Natural Resources and transnational movements in Latin-America. Latinam-Zine will also welcome essays submitted by experts coming from other fields when they are relevant to the issues specified above. It is published once twice a year, during the Fall semester.

## II. PUBLISHING STANDARDS

- 1) The papers submitted to the Latinam-Zine must fit the journal's editorial line, while observing the rules and guidelines listed below;
- 2) The articles submitted are evaluated by an editorial board and external reviewers, but its publication will not necessarily express the position of the editorial board or the Helena Lewin Chair in Latin American Studies. The authors are directly responsible for the articles submitted by them.
- 3) The Latinam-Zine publishes both articles and reviews. All the submitted material must be original, previously unpublished, and cannot be simultaneously submitted to another journal;
- 4) Papers are accepted in English, Spanish and Portuguese;
- 5) The originals should be sent to the Editorial Board of the Latinam-Zine, as electronic file, to the address indicated below, with identification of the author(s) and title of work. The originals of the works should be accompanied by the author(s)'s curriculum summarized, containing the information: names, institutional link, mailing address, telephone, fax and e-mail. This information will not be disclosed for publication.
- 6) The articles must be typed in Line Spacing 2 lines, with margins of 3 cm at the top and left margin and 2 cm in bottom and right margin, and presented in the Paper Size A4, printed on one side and with numbered pages. Articles should not exceed 7000 words and reviews shall not exceed 1.500 words;
- 7) Preferably, the text must be submitted in Adobe Reader, obeying the following recommendations:
  - Font Times New Roman 14 for title, 12 for the text, 10 for bibliographic citations and footnotes;
  - Justified alignment and paragraphs formatted with special in the first line indent, also for footnotes.
- 8) The articles submitted to editorial must contain an Abstract in English, with a maximum of 150 words each, up to 5 key-words, also in Portuguese/Spanish and English.
- 9) Citations should be abbreviated in the body text (author's last name, year of publication and, when in case, the page) and complete references to the end of the text, according to the Chicago Manual of Style, 14<sup>th</sup> edition. Footnotes should be confined to explanatory notes;
